

St. Pete Prep's Sick Policies

Sick children: To make sure an illness does not spread, sick children with a fever, diarrhea, vomiting, or who are not well enough to participate in the regular scheduled activities including outdoor play may not attend school. Also, children who are carrying a contagious illness can pass their sickness on to others within St. Pete Prep.

Mandatory: Children must be free of fever, vomiting, and diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to Saint Pete Prep. Also, when notified of a sick child, we ask that children be picked up promptly and do not return to school for **24 hours!**

You will be asked to pick up your child who has:

Fever with behavior changes or signs or symptoms of illness: an oral temperature over 101°F or under the armpit temperature over 100°F.

Diarrhea.

Vomiting.

Severe itching or rashes.

Difficulty breathing, chronic coughing or wheezing.

Any contagious condition including ringworm, head lice, or pink eye.

Constant pain in the stomach.

****In cases of fever, diarrhea and/or vomiting, the child should not return to care until 24 hours have passed since the last sign of the symptom.**

You may be asked to bring a note from a doctor or health care professional stating the child may return to child care when the illness is no longer contagious.
